REGINALD "DOC" HARVEY died at his home in Swarthmore on January 10, 1983, after a long illness. He was a member of the Brandywine and White Clay bike clubs as well as the DVBC, and those who knew him remember Doc for his willingness to help others regardless of his own problems, and for his just plain optomistic spirit in general. He would often take long rides on the weekends by himself, but always had time to give directions, help fix a flat, or chat. Doc and I rode togather on the WCBC's Delaware Double Century in 1977, a 200 mile ride from one end of the state to the other and back in one day, and I remember how the ride took us about 17 hours because he was always stopping to give motorists directions, or to chat with the people who ran the general stores along the route, etc. Doc lent out his patches, spare tires, food, and most of his tools that day, including his pump, usually to people he had never met before. It was a wonder that he still had the bike by the time we got back to Newark. But that's the kind of guy he was.

Doc will be missed by all who knew him, but it's good to know he isn't sick anymore.
